Project description:

John Dennis were delighted to be awarded the contract for Phase Five of the refurbishment of the Lady Victoria Colliery. Our association with the Scottish Mining Museum stretches back over twenty years and with the award of this contract we have continued our involvement in all the phases to date (with a collective spend of over ten million pounds) that have turned the once derelict colliery into a five star tourist attraction.

This phase consisted of the renovation of large workshop areas of approximately 2500m². We removed the existing roof coverings and either replaced or refurbished the existing steel truss members. New corrugated roof cladding and Georgian wire glass roof lights were fitted together with a full roof anchor safety system. The existing steel chequer-plate flooring and associated steel support members were replaced as necessary. We also carried out the re-building of arched and vaulted brickwork together with the full re-pointing of the internal and external walls. Internally a full lighting and emergency lighting system was installed.
